Ben Hill Griffin Stadium announced it has adopted a similar policy to the NFL regarding the size and type of bags allowed in the stadium. Each bag must be a clear plastic, vinyl or PVC bag that does not exceed 12"x 6"x 12". Also a new policy, personal seat backs will not be permitted inside the stadium. Seat cushions that are no larger than 16", do not have pockets, and do not have a back are permitted.

Brothers Making the News



Homecoming Discount for Ag and Gardening Day


